

1. Minimize registrations of exact TM matches by others

Mechanisms	Eligibility	Proponents
a) Register during Sunrise	Any TM in the TMCH	Required by ICANN
b) TM claim notices for at least 60 days	Any TM in the TMCH	Required by ICANN
c) Centralized Sunrise, for at least 60 days	Any TM in the TMCH	BC
d) TM claim notices should run indefinitely	Any TM in the TMCH	BC, Brand Summit

e) TM claim notice to registrar when their user does a Whois or check-command query on a TM	Any TM in the TMCH	Donuts

2. Minimize abusive registrations of domains closely related to TMs

Mechanisms	Eligibility	Proponents
a) Domains recovered in URS/UDRP go into the TMCH for Sunrise and Claims Notices	Any domain recovered in URS/UDRP	BC
b) TM notices for domains <i>including</i> the TM	Any TM in the TMCH	Donuts
c) TM notices for domains including TM + (any goods or services listed in TMCH registration)	Any TM in the TMCH	Brand Summit, BC
d) Block registration of domains including TM where TM does not want domain to resolve	Any TM in the TMCH	BC, Donuts

3. Tools to contact/suspend/recover abusive registrations once they've occurred

Mechanisms	Eligibility	Proponents
a) Require all registrars distributing new gTLD domains to adhere to amended RAA	All	BC
b) Validate contact information for registrant	Registrars in new gTLDs	BC

c) URS domains suspended if registrant does not pay Response Fee within 48 hours	High At-Risk Marks	Melbourne IT
d) URS managed by sole vendor, under ICANN	All	BC, Brand Summit
e) Loser pays in URS proceedings; default judgments require only admin fees	All	Brand Summit

4. Other ways ICANN can minimize abusive registrations
