- In the past, GNSO made use of Task Forces -small legislative bodies where decisionmaking was primarily based upon voting
- Working Groups are intended to be more open and inclusive; participants tackle issues using consensus-building approaches
- PPSC / Working Group Work Team tasked to develop appropriate operating principles, rules and procedures for working groups

Background



- PPSC submitted proposed GNSO Working Group Guidelines to GNSO Council on 1 January 2011
- GNSO Council conducted 21 day public comment period - 2 public comments received, plus statement from ALAC
- PPSC reviewed comments received and updated document accordingly
- Updated GNSO Working Group Guidelines submitted for GNSO consideration on 8 March
- Updated GNSO Working Group Guidelines adopted by the GNSO Council on 16 March
