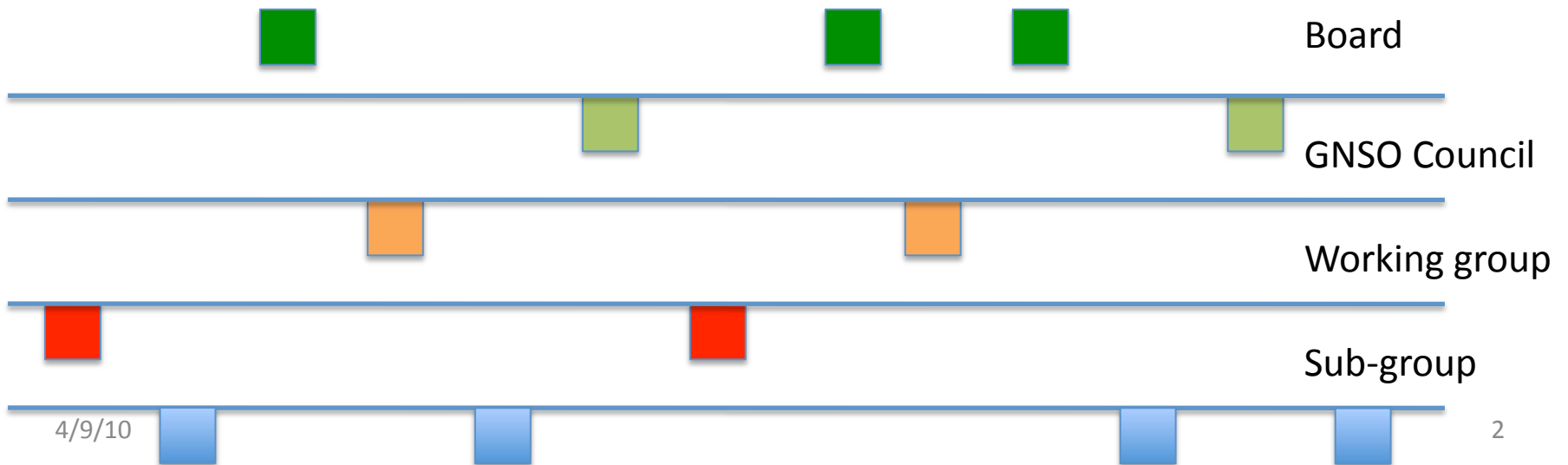

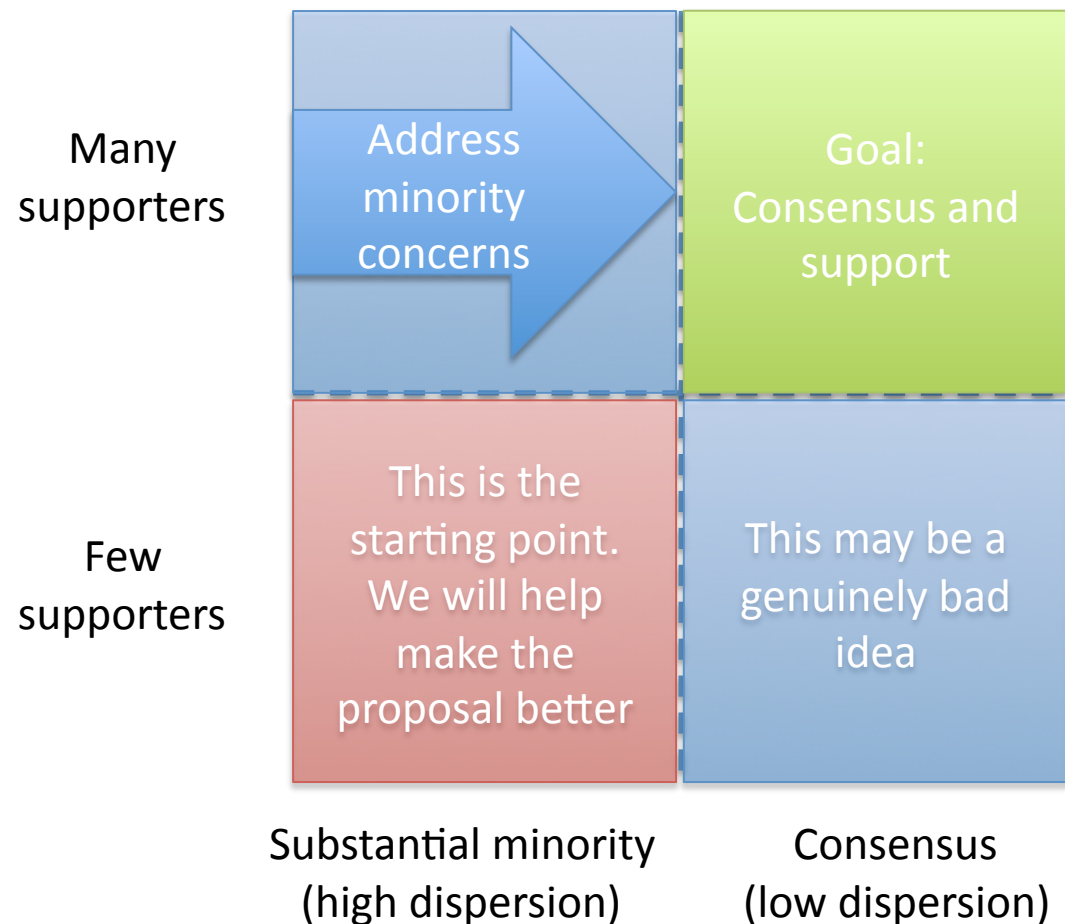
# What is the goal for a proposal?

- Approved by sub-group? – **good**
- Approved by working group? – **better**
- Approved by GNSO Council? – **better**
- Approved by Board = **goal**

# Roles

## **Opponents**

Describe objections  
Propose ideas,  
compromises

## **Supporters**

Solicit objections  
Propose ideas,  
compromises



## **Evaluators**

Ensure that definitions, use-cases and criteria are addressed

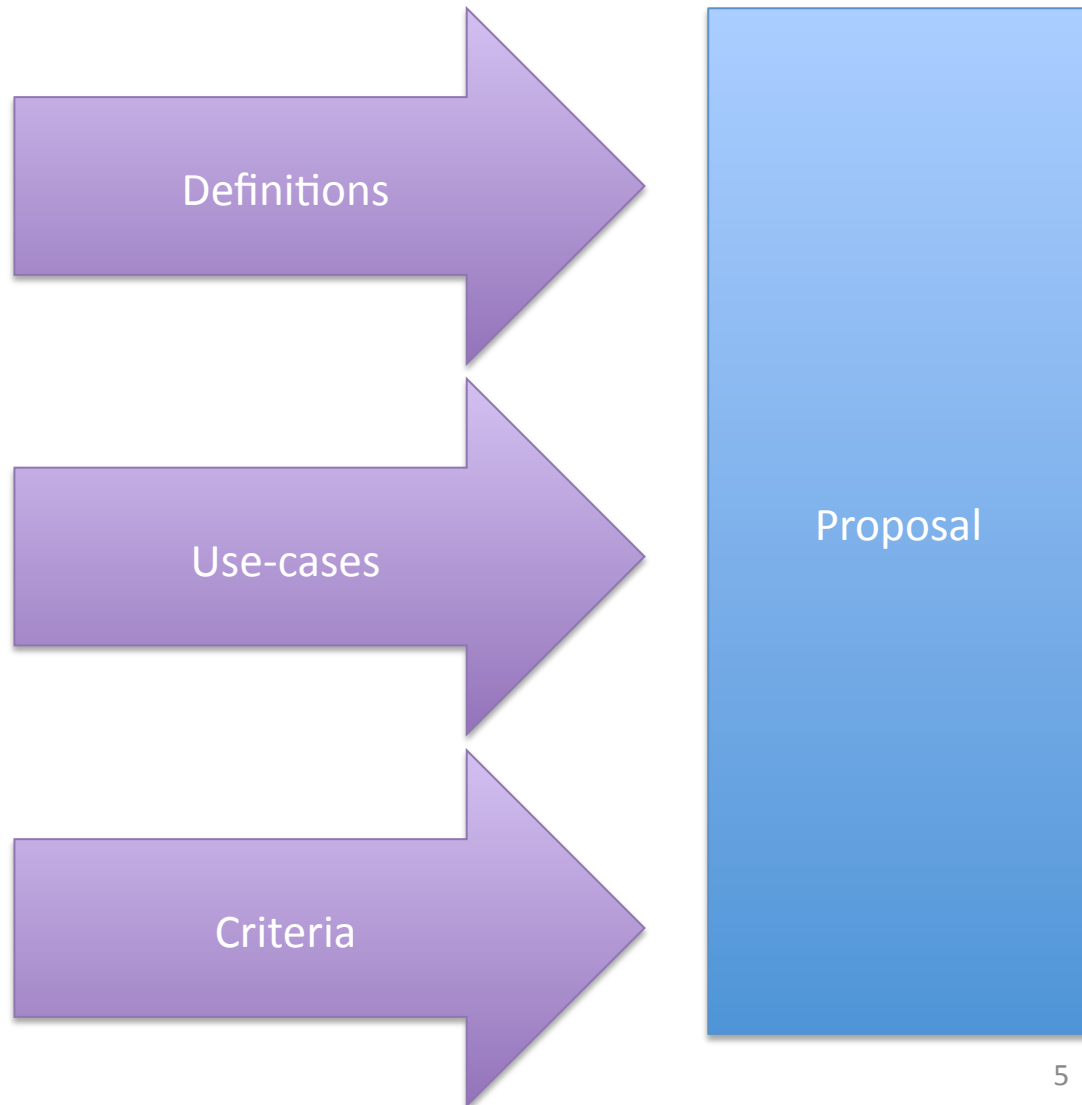
## **Proponents**

Carry the proposal  
Solicit and address objections from opponents

Note: “lurker” is not an approved role. 😊

# Evaluation “track”

- Definitions
  - What are the baseline definitions?
  - How does a given proposal differ from the baseline?
- Use-cases
  - Which use-cases will we consider?
  - Which ones would be permitted under a given proposal?
- Criteria
  - What criteria will we use?
  - How does a given proposal address them?



# Approach

- Identify Evaluation sub-group members
- Collect existing definitions, use-cases and criteria (post to wiki)
- Decide whether those are sufficient or revision is needed
- Develop preliminary draft, circulate for comment and publish (posting to wiki along the way)
- Assist proposal-proponents as they fold the lists (and answers) into their proposals
