<p>Deliverables/topics reviewed</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -On Monday 17 November, Klaus Stoll was appointed by the NCSG-Executive Committee as NCSG Councilor in replacement of Wolfgang Kleinwachter, NCSG Councilor who has been appointed to the ICANN Board; -The Program Committee Chair position is therefore vacant; -The NCSG-EC reviewed all 52 NCSG pending applications -We have 8 new organizational members approved; -We made three public comments during the public forum -We have been active making intervention in different sessions and working group sessions -Our I-Inform session has been a big success since the audience was important and represented an interested mixed people (David Olive, Bertrand de la Chapelle, the EU GAC rep, and others from the NGO community as well as ICANN fellows) -We have all the I-Inform outreach materials (Spanish and English) and the NPOC factsheet pamphlets published and delivered to us for its distribution at other ICANN events and I-Engage events, during the rest of our EC term. -Due to our outreach work, we have a list of organisations interested in joining NPOC and some has already applied; -We have reached an agreement with NCSG to improve the application mechanism that will allow us to have a monthly review and thus admits members every 4 weeks; -We have made (again) a strong lobby to obtain a NOMCOM seat with the support of Cheryl Langdon-Orr and Avri Doria; -We co-organized and participated a regional one day forum about DNS in LAC with key players in the region (LACNIC, LacTLD, ISOC, ICANN and PIR); -We had an NPOC rep in a four days pre-ICANN academy pilot leadership training; -An article about the DNS forum written by Paul Diaz from PIR where we were mentioned, was published in Circle ID widely read by the DNS sector; -We had a pretty crowded stakeholder session attended mostly by NGOs reps and ICANN fellows interested in applying to NPOC; -A meeting with some of the Costa Rican community members active at ICANN was sustained to start discussing the organization of LAC roadshow a local level in Costa Rica as part of the LAC ICANN regional strategy.
