Introduction

The attached statement on RAA subsection 3.7.7.3 was drafted by Beau Brendler, Chair of the At-Large Registrants Rights and Responsibilities Working Group and member of the At-Large Advisory Committee (ALAC) and Alan Greenberg, Vice Chair of the ALAC.

On June 24th, Beau submitted the draft statement for review to the members of the ALAC, the leaders of the regional At-Large organisations and the ALAC liaisons. Alan Greenberg amended the original Statement. There were several comments received on the internal ALAC mailing list in support of Revision 1 of the Statement (the present document).

On July 9th, ALAC Vice Chair Sebastien Bachollet asked the Staff to start a nine-day online vote on the ALAC Statement on RAA subsection 3.7.7.3.

Also on July 9th, the Statement was submitted to the [public consultation on Registrar Accreditation Agreement \(RAA\) Subsection 3.7.7.3](#) on behalf of the ALAC with a note saying that the document was currently undergoing ALAC ratification.

ALAC Statement on RAA subsection 3.7.7.3

The ALAC supports the text and the intent of RAA section 3.7.7.3, the effect of which creates accountability and transparency with regard to registered name holders. Specifically, RAA section 3.7.7.3 contains provisions to increase accountability and transparency in name registration abuse.

Therefore, the ALAC strongly supports the proposed Advisory Notice (<http://icann.org/en/public-comment/#raa-3773>) which will increase the compliance with and enforceability of the section 3.7.7.3 provisions.
