- Internationalized domain name (IDN) guidelines exist for domain labels and names.
- No standards exist for submission and display of internationalized domain registration data in directory services.

Purpose:

Joint Working Group of the Generic Names Supporting Organization (GNSO) and the Security and Stability Advisory Committee (SSAC) to study the feasibility and suitability of introducing submission and display specifications to deal with the internationalization of Registration Data.



Background and Current Status



- **2009:** Internationalized Registration Data Working Group (IRD-WG) established by ICANN Board.
- **2009-2010:** Study feasibility and suitability of introducing submission and display specifications for the internationalization of registration data.
- **Nov 2010:** Published Interim Report: <http://gns0.icann.org/issues/ird/ird-wg-final-report-15nov10-en.pdf>.
- **Nov 2010-Present:** Analyze comments on Interim Report; begin producing Final Report.

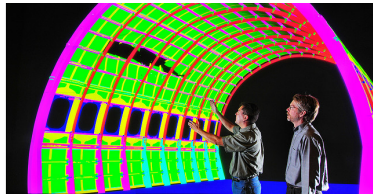


Update on Activities
